With reference to your letter cited above on the subject, the site inspection was carried out on 29.04.2022 by Smt. Ch.Suseela, JMG accompanied by Sri V.T.Chander, Qualified Person and Sri Shaik Mehboob,Lessee's Representative. The draft Final Mine Closer Plan has been examined and the scrutiny comments have already been forwarded to you and your Qualified Person on respective e-mail id's i.e., deccanlimestonemine@gmail.com and ccgeoengg@gmail.com

02.You are advised to attend the deficiencies as per the annexure and resubmit the document, complete in all respects, in three bound copies along with soft copy in the form of CD (4Nos.). In this regard, you are directed to submit the Financial Assurance in the form of Bank Guarantee for the area put on use for Mining and allied activities @ Rs.Five lakhs/hectare for category 'A' mines provided that the minimum amount shall be Rs.Ten lakhs and @ Rs.Three Lakhs/hectare for category 'B'mines provided that the minimum amount shall be Rs.Five lakhs as per the provision of Rule 27(1) of MCDR, 2017 at the time of submission of final copies of the document within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of issue of this letter, failing which the document will be disposed without giving any further opportunity.

03. The para-wise clarification & the manner in which the deficiencies are attended should be given while forwarding modified document.

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Scrutiny Comments in respect of Final Mine Closure Plan of Mothugapadu Limestone Mine of M/s Deccan Limestone Mining Co.(P) Ltd.over an extent of 18.62 ha in Madhavaram Village, Peapully Mandal, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh State.

- The document is to be submitted as per the chapters mentioned in Format of FMCP in IBM manual on appraisal of Mining Plan 2014.
- 2. Lease details needs to be mentioned on the cover page. The Rule under which the Final Mine Closure Plan submitted is to be mentioned as 24 of MCDR, 2017.
- 3. The legal obligations, if any which the lessee is bound to implement the conditions imposed by the MoEF, State or Central Pollution Control Board or by any other organization describing the nature of conditions and compliance position thereof may be indicated and the copies of relevant documents may be attached as Annexure.
- 4. Para 1.1.3- Status of the Lessee is given as partnership Firm instead of Private Limited Co. Needs to be corrected.
- 5. Para 1.2.3, date of grant of the lease needs to be furnished.
- 6. Para 1.2.4, period of the first renewal period needs to be furnished.
- Para 1.4.1, reasons for not drilling 8 core bore holes as proposed in the last approved document needs to be furnished.
- 8. Para 1.4.21, Survival Rate for the actual plantation needs to be furnished.
- 9. Para 1.4.24 to 1.4.27, it is mentioned as 'No action was initiated' against measures for control of dust, noise and ground vibration, Quality of Air and Water, though there was a proposal for monitoring the environmental parameters in the last approved document. Clarification may be given in this regard.
- 10. Para 2.4, exploration may be proposed in the pit bottom by drilling 8 bore holes already proposed in the last approved document to know the depth persistence of the mineral. If the mineral is found existing, no backfilling should be done.
- 11. In Page 26, the expiry of the lease period is stated as 2.9.2022 instead of 1.9.2022. Proposed production is furnished differently in different places. Please furnish the correct quantity in all the relevant places.

- 12. Para 5.1.1, Submit the proposals to be implemented for reclamation and rehabilitation of mined-out land. The proposals may be supported with relevant plans and sections depicting the method of land restoration/reclamation/rehabilitation.
- 13. Para 5.1.2, it is stated that existing dump shall be terraced with proper maintenance of slope and garland drainage shall be developed around the dump. However, during the inspection, it was observed that there is no dump existing in the lease area. The worked out pits should be fenced to prevent access to the surface openings, excavations etc.
- 14. Para 5.1.3, details of existing afforestation shall be furnished. Plantation shall be proposed on ultimate benches, virgin area, 7.5 m safety zone, indicating area to be covered and number of saplings .Total degraded area is to be stabilized and plantation is to be made as the measure of reclamation and rehabilitation.
- 15. As the mining lease area is going to be expired on 1.9.2022, entire proposal should be submitted so that the reclamation and rehabilitation work should be completed before 1.9.2022. Further, an appropriate reason for delay in submission of Final Mine Closure Plan may be given.
- 16. Financial Assurance should be calculated for reclamation and rehabilitative works and submitted with the validity up to 31.3.2023 and the claim period up to 31.3.2024.
- 17. Post closure cost of watch and care, security and supervision is to be furnished.
- 18. The lessee may give an undertaking to the effect that all the measures proposed in the closure plan will be implemented in a time bound manner as proposed.

19. Annexure No. I,II,III,IV,VIII and IX are not legible. Please furnish the clear and legible copies of the same.

Plans and sections:

- 20. **Key Plan**: Co –Ordinate range of Mining lease area may be drawn.
- 21. DGPS survey of lease area authenticated by State Government for compliance of CCOM circular no. 2/ 2010 should be submitted.
- 22. Surface Plan: Bench Mark, Ground Control Points etc. should be depicted. The surface plan should be signed by the surveyor having Certificate of Competency of Survey from DGMS.
- 23. Surface Geological Plan: Exploration of 8 core boreholes proposed during the last plan period were not carried out. Hence proposal may be made to carry out exploration to know the depth persistence of the mineral and the Proposed boreholes are to be marked on the plan. Geological cross sections are to be marked on the plan.
- 24. **Geological sections**: UNFC codes should be marked.
