Annual Returns since the year 2016-17 and 2017-18 have not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad, so far, as required under this rule.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 45(5) is liable for suspension of mining operations under Rule Rule 45(7) (i)(a) of MCDR,2017.
- 03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
