

On examination of the office records following provisions of the Minerals Conservation and Development

RULE NO.	NATURE OF VIOLATION OBSERVED		
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines. Whereas on perusal of office records, it is found that the mining operations were carried out without approved mining plan, the details of mining is as follows:

	Thus the mining operations were carried out in contraventions to the provision of rule as the mining operations carried out without any approved proposals/ without approved mining plan.		
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30 th day of June every year submit to the authorized officer a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. However, the lessee has not submitted the copies of the plans and sections as per rules for the year 2017-18 & 2018-19		
45(5)(b)	Monthly returns have not been submitted by the lessee to the Regional Controller/authorized officer of Indian Bureau of Mines for months from January 2019 onwards.		
45(5)(c)	Annual returns for the year ending 31st March 2019 has not been submitted by the lessee to the Regional Controller/authorized officer of Indian Bureau of Mines.		

- 2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.
- 3. Mining operations can be suspended as per rule 11(2) in case of non compliance of rule 11(1).
- 4. May Advise the State Government to order suspension of all mining operation in the mine as per provision of Rule 45(7), in case incomplete or wrong or false information has been furnished in statutory returns or fails to submit statutory returns under rule 45.

- 5. May initiate appropriate action in accordance with any competent orders/directives etc.
- 6. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and / or why mining operation can be suspended under statutory provisions and/or why not any other action can be initiated in accordance with any competent orders/directives.
- 7. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
