Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Hemadri Limestone Mine over an extent of 38.68 ha situated in Vedadri village, Jaggayyapeta mandal in Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh state.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 (MCDR, 2017), were found violated in your above mine during the site inspection of modified mining plan on 24.01.2018 by Shri S.K. Mudali, JMG and Shri Y.M. Shiva Prasad, AME of this office and accompanied by Sri P.R. Mishrs, QP and Shri Ponnu Swamy, Manager(Mines), of your mine.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017, further the mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017, if compliance of rules 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
