Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Venkateswara Limestone Mine over an extent of 38.46 ha situated in Vedadri village, Jaggaiahpet mandal in Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 (MCDR, 2017), were found violated in your above mine during the site inspection of modified mining plan on 25.01.2018 by Shri Subrata.Kumar. Mudali, JMG and Shri Y.M. Shiva Prasad, AME of this office and accompanied by Shri Ponnu Swamy, Manager(Mines) of your mine.

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the Mining Plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.	Mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Modified Mining Plan vide letter no. AP/KSN/MP/Lst-32/Hyd dated 29.02.2016 to the extent indicated below: i. As proposed in the Approved Modified Mining Plan 500 nos of saplings will be planted on 7.5 m Barrier Zone SE, East side & near Temple. But the same sapling plantation has not been done so far.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.	The yearly report for the year 2016-17 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved scheme of Mining has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.

55(1)(c)(i)	Every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category 'A' mines, a Whole time Mining Engineer and a Geologist having minimum 5 years professional experience in field of mining.	But the said statutory staff has not been appointed to look after the job of Mining Engineer and Geologist as per rule.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017, further the mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017, if compliance of rules 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
