Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of Arasmeta Limestone mine lease – 3 over an area of 46.292 ha in Arasmeta village, Akaltara Mandal & Janjgir-Champa District, Chattisgarh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 24.05.2016 by undersigned in the presence of Sri Ritesh Kaimal, AGM(Mines).

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
42(1)©(i)	For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules:“Every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category ‘A’ mines, a full time mining engineer and a full time Geologist”. A full time Mining Engineer & Geologist under this Rule has not been employed.
Rule 45(5)(a)(vi ii)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines a monthly return which shall be submitted be Submitted in Form F-8 before 10 th of every month in respect of preceding month has not been submitted since opening of the mine.
Rule 45(5)(b)(vi ii)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines a Annual return which shall be submitted be Submitted in Form F-8 before 1 st July of each year for the preceding financial year has not been submitted since opening of the mine.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rules 45(5) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under the provision of Rule 45(7) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
