

Subject: Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 inrespect of you

Chachandih bauxite mine in District of Anuppur in M.P. State over an area of 17.744 Ha.

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 21/02/2020 by the undersigned in presence of Mr. Ramawtar Agarwal, owner of mines.

Rule.	Nature of violations observed .
Rule 46 of MCDR 2017	46. Notice of certain appointments.—The holder of the prospecting licence or prospecting license cum mining lease or the mining lease shall,— (a) when any new appointment of an agent, mining engineer, geologist or any person is made under sub-rule (1) of rule 55; or (b) when the employment of any such person is terminated or any such person leaves the said employment; or Notice for mining engineer and geologist is not submitted under this rule.
Rule 26(2) MCDR 2017	(2) The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:
	Statement /yearly report for year 18-19 for progressive closure under this rule is not submitted.
Rule 35(2) MCDR 2017	35. Sustainable mining.—(1) Every holder of a mining lease shall take all possible precautions for undertaking sustainable mining while conducting prospecting, mining, beneficiation or metallurgical operations in the area. (2) Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its selfassessment report before the 1st day of July every year for the previous financial year, alongwith the soft copy (in the standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31st day of March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometres from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorised officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines. You have not submitted online self assessment report before the 1st day of July 2019 for the

Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exproration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Par B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.
	Plantatation were not raised over entire backfilled area(5000 M2) as required under yearly proposal for reclaimation and rehabilitataion of mined out area given in approved mining plant for the lease valid upto year 20-21.

02.In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.

03 . You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
