Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Devnagar Iron Ore, Mn & Bauxite Mine (6.44 Ha), Mine code 75MPR18019 at Village Devnagar, Teh-Sihora, Jabalpur (M.P.)

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected the abovementioned mine in the presence of representative of owner and QP on 25/07/2019. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines during inspection.

## Nature of violation observed in detail

Rule 26 (2) The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1<sup>st</sup> day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:

During the scrutiny of office records, it has been observed that yearly report as per the rule 26(2) has not been submitted to this office.

Rule 28. Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines and obligations of lease holders- (1) Subject to the provisions of section 4A. the holder of the mining lease shall send to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a notice in Form E when the mining or mineral processing operations in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them with in one hundred and twenty days from the date of the such temporary discontinuance.

During the scrutiny of office records, it has been observed that Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines has not been submitted to this office.

Rule 33 Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.

During the scrutiny of office records, it has been observed that a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32 has not been submitted to this office.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
- 3. Please note that no further notice will be given in this regard.
