Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Lalpur Limestone Mine (17.471 Ha) Village – Lalpur, P.O. – Siding, District-Satna, M.P. Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of Mines officials and QP on 01/08/2019. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

Rule No

Nature of violation observed in detail

Rule 11(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. During inspection it was found that the following provisions of the rule have been violated:-

The Scheme of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.» MP/Satna/Limestone/ M.Sch-67/ 2014-15 dated 06/04/2015 incorporating working proposals for 2014-15 to 2017-18. During inspection it was found that top soil and waste has been stacked/dumped near the Eastern boundary near boundary pillar no. 1, 2 and 3 and scattered out side the lease area.

Rule 28. Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines and obligations of lease holders- (1) Subject to the provisions of section 4A. the holder of the mining lease shall send to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a notice in Form E when the mining or mineral processing operations in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them with in one hundred and twenty days from the date of the such temporary discontinuance.

During the scrutiny of office records, it has been observed that Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines has not been submitted to this office.

Rule 33 Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.

No such plans and sections have been submitted by lessee at this office as per office records.

- 45(5)(b) The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner namely:-
 - (b) A monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth of the day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with the signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form.

During the scrutiny of office records it has been observed that the monthly returns since June-2019 have not been filed in the electronic form.



- 2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 immediately after approval of mining plan and intimate the position to this office.
- 4. You are advised to rectify the violations of rules 28, 33 & 45(5)(b) immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
