The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by Shri Sanjay M. Girhe, Regional Mining Geologist on 22.02.2021 in presence of Shri. Vivek Dubey, Manager (Mines), Shri Puneet Shukla, Geologist & Shri Suraj Pandey, Foreman as detailed under:-

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016</p> <p>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Katni/Limestone/M. Sch-17/16-17 dated 16.12.2016 incorporating the proposals of working from 2017-18 to 2021-22. Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</p> <p>But, in your case the aforesaid Report in prescribe Form for the year 2019-20 is not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection.</p>						
Rule 45(1)	<p>The holder of the mining lease, or any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end use or export of minerals mined in the country, shall cause himself to be registered online with the Indian Bureau of Mines as per application specified in Form-K of the Schedule and the registration number so allotted by the Indian Bureau of Mines shall be used for all purpose of online reporting and correspondence connected therewith</p> <p>But, it is observed that you have not done online MTS registration in prescribed form so for till the date inspection & thus violated above provision of rule.</p>						

Rule 45(5)(b)	<p><i>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller of Mine or any other authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner-</i></p> <p>A Monthly Return which shall be submitted before tenth day of every month in respect of preceding month in electronic form, along with signed print copy of the same if it is digitally signed, in the respective Form</p> <p>But, it is observed that, online monthly return for the month of January-2021 was not submitted till the date of inspection to this Regional office. It is also directed to submit aforesaid returns in online system immediately through www.ibm.gov.in/index.php/auth/login.</p>

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
03. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) & of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017. Further, for the non-compliance of Rule 45(5)(b) of MCDR-2017, necessary action shall be initiated as deemed fit under the provision of rule 45(7) of MCDR,2017.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
