CIRCULAR

Subject:- Canvassing of political or other outside influence by the employees of IBM - regarding.

It has come to the notice of the Competent Authority that few employees of IBM are bringing political or other outside influence to bear upon the senior authorities to further their interest pertaining to transfer or other service matters. It has also been observed that the relatives of some employees make representatives concerning transfer or service matters affecting the Government employees.

Instructions have been issued from time to time to desist from such irregular practices. In fact, Circular dated 30.03.2017 has been issued on notice of such unwanted incidents. It is to reiterate that such activities by the Government employees or their family members are not in order in terms of CCS (Conduct) Rule, 1964. Even in one such instance, the matter has been viewed very seriously by Ministry of Mines.

All Officers and Staff of IBM are, therefore, requested to be careful and advised not to bring political or other outside influence on the superior authorities in favour of their service matters and to desist from such irregular practices that are against the provisions of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964.

If any employee of IBM is found violating the provisions of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, suitable disciplinary action would be initiated against such erring employees under the provisions of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965.
