Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Saliya Limestone mining lease over an extent of 459.566 hect. in district Satna of Madhya Pradesh.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 30.08.2018 in presence of Shri Shailendra Jain, Shri Damodar Sharma (Mining Engineer) and Shri Bharat Sahasrabudhe (Mining Geologist)

Nature of violation observed

11(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.

The Scheme of Mining of Salaiya Limestone Mining Lease was approved on 06.04.2016 for the proposal period 06.04.2016 to 31.3.2021. As per the approved proposals for the year 2018-19 it was proposed to carry out backfilling in between UTM Grid Coordinates 2666900 N & 2667100 N and 475200 E & 475400 E in the north block (Refer page no 27 and Plan no. 6 Sheet-3of approved mining scheme).

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

 The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.

3. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
