

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mines in during the Mining Plan inspection on 31/10/2019 by the undersigned in

presence of Mr. SP Sharma, Sr GM.	
Rule.	Nature of violations observed .
11(1) of MCDR 2017	Mining operations under mining lease.—(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureauof Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Actwhere the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the act.  In case of your naubasta mines, it is observed:  1. Production is very less than planned quantityie.69670tons against proposed 13,02,155 tons.  2. Pit in south block was not opened.  3. Plantatation of 2000 saplings was not done.
32 of MCDR 2017	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted.— The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the soundary of June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and section maintained under rule 32.

03. Further it is informed that the mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
