	4. It was approved to carry out working below HFL of 53.34 meters with due permission of Directorate of Mines Safety (DMS) and "protective bund all along the HFL (Highest Flood Level) contour and water front".
	During the inspection it was observed that mining operations are being carried out up to 42.12 meters in Pit-1 and 40.175 meters in Pit-2 without obtaining permission from DMS and without constructing "protective bund all along HFL contour", which is not in the interest of systematic and safe mining.

Due to the **Pulichintla project** on Krishna River, HFL (High Flood Level) in the region is 53.34 meters above MSL which bay in to lease area below HFL on North-western and Southern side, covering an area of about 42.318 Ha. In this regard commitment was made to obtain permission from Directorate of Mines Safety (DMS) and to construct "protective bund all along the HFL (Highest Flood Level) contour and water front" to carry out mining operations.

Working has been extended within the HFL zone, which is not as per the approved plan and corrective action has not been taken which jeopardize the Systematic and scientific Mining. Also bund on either side of nala has not been constructed.

- 2. It was approved to construct 'Bund' on either side of the seasonal nala to protect it, but the same is not done.
