Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR,2017) in respect of your Muddapur Limestone & Dolomite Mine, over an area of 17.89 Ha. in Tq- Mudhol, Bagalkot Dist. of Karnataka state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules'2017 were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 23.05.2019 by the undersigned in the presence of Mr. Murali Manas P., Mines Manager and other officials of your mine.

| 11 (1) | <p>The Mining operations required to be carried out in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines. However, Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the Modification of Mining Plan (MMP) approved dated:-05.03.2019 to the extent indicated below:-</p> <p>(i) As per approved MMP (PMCP), the dumps will be stabilized and afforested by planting good root bearing species and retaining wall with garland drain will be constructed surrounding the toe of the waste dumps to check the erosion and prevent silt being carried away during monsoon.</p> <p>However, it was observed during inspection that waste dump was not terraced and stabilized by doing plantation and also not protected by retaining wall with garland drain.</p> <p>(ii) As per approved MMP (PMCP), 7.5 m safety barrier/zone has to be maintained all along the lease boundary. However, the same observed to be encroached by waste dumping near to Crusher Ramp/waste disposal site.</p> <p>(iii) As per approved MMP (PMCP), air pollution proposed to be controlled by way of dust suppression by providing water pipe line at all discharge points at Crusher. However, no such dust suppression system observed provided in the Crushing and Screening plants.</p> <p>(iv) Direction/Shape of Mining Lease area as shown over the precise area lease sketch/map (Khasra/Cadastral plan) observed to be not in consonance with Direction/Shape of Mining Lease area as shown over the Geo-Referenced vectorised Cadastral Map (DGPS Plan).</p> |

| 35 (2) | High resolution satellite image as on 31 st March for that financial year covering the mining lease and area of two km from the lease boundary, ought to be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year to the Regional controller, has not been submitted so far for the year 2017-18. Violation in this respect was also issued previously by this office, however the same has not been complied so far. |
| 45 (7) | (i) 449.38 te of ROM ore (Dolomite) reported as closing stock at mine head in Annual return of financial year 2017-18. However, the same was not reported (shown NIL) in the opening stock of subsequent Monthly Returns submitted for the month of April 2018 & onwards. (ii) 449.38 te of processed ore (Dolomite) reported as closing stock at mine head in Monthly Return submitted for the month of April 2019 was not observed stacked at the mine head. |

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
03. *The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11 (2), if compliance of Rule 11 (1) is not found satisfactory.*
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations **immediately** and intimate the position to this office **within 45 (forty-five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
