Sub:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Yadwad Limestone Mine M.L.No-2428 over an area of 16.18Ha.situated in Yadwad- Village, Taluka-Gokak Distt.-Belgaum, of Karnataka-State

Dear Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 was found violated during the inspection of your above mine on 29/08/2013 (FN) by the undersigned.

45(5)(b)	<i>An annual return for the year 11-12 & 2012-13 which shall be submitted before the 1st July of the preceding financial year in the prescribed form-H-8 but in your case you have submitted the said return with following deficiencies as given below-Part-I (i) lease area utilization details is incorrect & left blank. Part-II, & III left blank. Part-V details are incorrect & left blank. Part-VI Sale /dispatch column left blank.</i>
42(1)(c)(ii)	A whole time Mining engineer / Geologist have not been employed for the purpose of carrying out mining operations in accordance with these rules.
29	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of mine shall submit the copy of plan & section on or before the 30 th June of every year but in your case you have not submitted the said updated plan & section maintained under rule 28 to this office till date.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. The relevant extract of the rule 58 is given below:

“58 Penalty: - Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rule shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to **two years**, or with fine extending to **fifty thousand rupees** or with both, and in the case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to **five thousand rupees** for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeated contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only”.

In this connection it is once again brought to your notice that the non-compliance of above violation, under rule 45(7) (1) MCDR 1988 (Revised MCDR.2011) the following action may be initiated:

1. All mining operation may be suspended.
2. Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules.
3. It may be recommended for termination of mining lease to the State Government.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
