Sub:- Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Dhawaleshwar Dolomite Mine M.L.No-2282 over an area of 4.86Ha.situated in Dhawaleshwar-Village, Gokak-Tq., Distt.-Belgaum, Karnataka-State

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated during the inspection of your above mine on 08/6/2013 FN by the undersigned.

Rule No.	Nature of violation observed in detail
45(5)(b)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner:- <i>An annual return for the year 2011-12 & 2012-13 which shall be submitted before the 1st July of the preceding financial year in the prescribed form-H-8 but it has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines Goa office till date.</i>
24(1)	Mining operations in the lease area were found temporarily closed since July,2010, but the notice in form D-1 has not been submitted even after more than 90 days from temporary discontinuance.

02. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR 1988. The relevant extract of Rule 58 is given below:

“58 Penalty: - Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rule shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to **two years**, or with fine extending to **fifty thousand rupees** or with both, and in the case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to **five thousand rupees** for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeated contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only”.

In this connection it is once again brought to your notice that the non-compliance of above violation, under rule 45(7) (1) MCDR 1988 (Revised MCDR.2011) the following action may be initiated:

1. All mining operation may be suspended.
2. Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules.
3. It may be recommended for termination of mining lease to the State Government.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
