Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Mauli Iron Ore Mine of 32.83 Ha, situated in Redi-Village, Vengurla-Taluka, Distt. Sindhudurg, State Maharashtra.

Dear Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 was found violated during the inspection of your above mine on 15/02/2013 by the undersigned.

13(1)	1.As per the approved Scheme of mining for the period 2009-10 to 2013-14, there was a proposal to produce 267057, 230064 & 204375 tonnes of iron ore and 951840,949,860 & 52470 tonnes of overburden during the year 2009-10,2010-11 & 2011-12. However, it is observed from the annual return submitted under Rule 45 of MCDR 1988 that 97898,149861 & 181699 tonnes of iron ore & 364224,537856 & 680490 tonnes of overburden has been produced during the said period thereby short fall in the quantity of iron ore by 169159,80203 & 22676 tonnes, respectively. During the year 2011-12 the OB handling is exceeded by 628020 tonnes.
47	During the year 2009-10 to 2012-13, 22, exploratory holes have been drilled in the area but intimation in form 'J' has not been sent to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Goa so far.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. The relevant extract of the rule 58 is given below:

"58 Penalty: - Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rule shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to **two years**, or with fine extending to **fifty thousand rupees** or with both, and in the case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to **five thousand rupees** for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeated contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only". ".

Further the violation of Rule 13 (1) of MCDR may also attract provisions of Rule 13 (2) of MCDR 1988 regarding suspension of mining operations till the compliance of violation.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Fourty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
