**Subject** : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 in respect of your **Khursipar Iron Ore Mine** over an area of 9.32 Hect. in Gondia district of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

On examination of this office records and as per the inspection of your mines by the undersigned, it is observed that the following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 amended vide notification of GSR 75(E) dated 09.02.2011 are violated in respect of your above referred mine.

<b>Rule</b>	<b>Nature of violations observed</b>
45(5)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner, namely:- (b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1 <sup>st</sup> July each year for the preceding financial year in the form as indicated below:- (i) <b>for iron ore in Form H-1;</b>
45(7)	If it is found that the owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of the mine has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in the monthly or special or annual return or fails to submit a return within the date specified, then the Regional Controller of Mines may,- a) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and may revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; b) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules; c) recommend termination of the mining lease in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining  <i>However, it is observed that, you have not submitted annual return for the year 2012-2013 in Form H-1.</i>  <i>Thus, you have violated rule 45(5) and 45(7) of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988. These violations lead to suspension of all mining operations in the mine as well as termination of mining lease and prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.</i>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violation of said rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.
03. You are, therefore, **directed to show-cause within a period of 30 days** from the date of issue of this letter, as to why mining operations in your above mine should not be suspended in accordance to rule 45(7) of MCDR, 1988.
04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
