Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 21.09.2013 by the undersigned along with Mr. Krishnendu Chettarjee, Jr. Mining Geologist in the presence of yourself and Mr. Arun Kumar – Mining Engineer and MK Jagadish – Geologist.

03. You are, advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
