The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988 was found violated during the inspection of your mine on 24.09.2013 by the undersigned and communicated to you vide this office Regd. A/D letter No. even dated 08.02.2013 giving a period of 45 (forty five) days time for rectification of the same. However, the compliance the status of compliance has not to be found to be satisfactory in respect of following violations.

Rule No.	Nature of violation observed
27(4)	The plans and sections have been examined during field inspection it was noticed that updation has not been done properly at all the major lithounit viz., Banded, Hematite Quartzite exposed prominently in the lease area has not been plotted at all on the Surface Geological Plan. Hence, you are directed to update the Surface Geological Plan by plotting Banded, Hematite and Quartzite and resubmit updated plans and sections to this office at the earliest.

42(1)( c ) (i)	A whole time Geologist has not been employed in accordance with this rule. It had already been communicated to you vide letter of even No. dated 07.06.2013 to appoint a whole time Geologist and submit notice to this office within Thirty days (30). But no Geologist has been appointed so far, hence the rule still continues to be violated.

02 In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR 1988. The relevant extract of the rule 58 is given below :

“58 Penalty :- Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rule shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to two years, or with fine extending to fifty thousand rupees or with both, and in the case of continuing contravention”.

04. You are, therefore, directed to **Show Cause within a period of (thirty) 30 days** from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above said offence.

05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
