Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of Dedar Iolite Mine over an area of 1.00 ha of M/s Gems & Minerals, in Kalahandi District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR'88) were found violated during the inspection of mine on 10th July'2013 by Shri N M Dey, Assistant Mining Engineer. The violation cum show cause notice was also communicated to you vide this office letter no: T/MCDR/2/BBS-2011/3195 dated 11.01.2012 for rectification of the same.

Rule No. Nature of Violation

13(1): Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.

During inspection it was observed that presently your above mentioned mine is not having an excavation proposal of mining and allied activities in the form of either a Mining Plan under Rule 22/24A of MCR, 1960 or a Scheme of Mining approved under Rule 12(2) & (3) of MCDR, 1988.

- **02**. However, it has been found that even after lapse of more than one and half year from the issue of violation cum show cause notice, you have not responded.
- **03**. In this regard, it is brought to your notice that the inability to comply violation of Rule 13(1) attracts provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR 88, further the violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR'88.
- **04.** You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and/or mining operations in the mine should not suspended in accordance to rule13 (2) of the MCDR, 1988.
- **05**. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
