Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of Dedar Iolite Mine of Shri Ghanashyam Agrawal, over an area of 9.5 ha in Kalahandi District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR'88) were found violated during the inspection of mine on 9th July'2013 by Shri N M Dey, Assistant Mining Engineer. **The violation was also communicated to you vide this office letter of even no dated 10.04.2012 for rectification of the same**.

Rule No. Nature of Violation

24 (1): The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine shall send to Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller of Mines a notice in Form D-1 when the mining operation in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding 90 days so as to reach them within one hundred and five days from the date of such temporary discontinuance.

Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines from 01.04.2009 in Form D-1 has not been submitted to this office.

45(5) (a) (viii) & (b) (viii): A monthly return shall be submitted before the 10th of every month in respect of preceding month.

During inspection it was observed that Monthly return, since April, 2011 has not been submitted to this office.

An annual return shall be submitted before the 1st July each year for the preceding financial year.

During inspection it was observed that Annual return, since 2004-05 have not been submitted to this office.

In this connection it is brought to your notice that incomplete or wrong or false information in annual return or failing to submit the annual return by 1st July, the mining operations in the mine are liable to be suspended under Rule 45 (7) (i).

- **02**. However, it has been found that even after lapse of more than 1 year from the issue of violation letter, you have not responded to the violation letter.
- **03**. In this regard, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 and Rule 45 (7) (i) of MCDR'88.
- **04.** You are, therefore, directed to show cause with in a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and / or mining operations in the mine should not suspended in accordance to Rule 45 (7) (i) of MCDR, 1988.
- **05**. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
