Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of Dudukamal Graphite Mine of Shri N L Agrawal., over an area of 2.428 ha in Bolangir District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR'88) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection by Shri N M Dey, Assistant Mining Engineer accompanied by Shri Bikash Mohanty, Surveyor on 7th July'2013 itself.

Rule being violated	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
25	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine shall send to Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller of Mines an intimation in Form- C of reopening of a mine after temporary discontinuance, so as to reach them within fifteen days from the date of such reopening	Your mine was stated to be temporarily closed and opened again with effect from 15 th June 2013. However, till date you have not submitted Reopening Notice in Form C to this office even after a lapsed of 15 days from the date of opening.

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. The relevant extract of the rule 58 is given below:

“58. Penalty:- Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to two years, or with fine extending to fifty thousand rupees or with both, and in case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to five thousand rupees for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeat contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only”

03. You are therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the actions taken by you in this regard to this office with in 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
