Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 in your Gondkida Chinaclay mines (Area 26.591 hects) in Singhbhum (west) district of Jharkhand State. Sir.

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 was found violated in the above mine during inspection on 30/10/2013 by the undersigned.

Rule 12(3):-The mining plan for this mine was approved vide letter no KOL/SB(W)/CC/MP- 620 Dated 31/12/2008 has expired on 31/03/2013. But the Scheme of mining for the next plan period i.e. from 2013-14 to 2017-18 has not been submitted for approval to the Regional Controller of Mines on or before 120 (One hundred twenty days) before the expiry of the five years period, for which it was approved on the last occasion i.e. on or before 02/12/2012.

- 02. Violation of Rule 12(3) of MCDR,1988 will also attract the violation of Rule 13(1)of MCDR,1988 as per the provision of Rule 12(6) of MCDR,1988.
- 03.It is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 58, of MCDR'1988.
- 04. You are therefore, directed to Show Cause within a period of 30(Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence and/or why the mining operation in the mine shall not be suspended as per provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 till compliance of Rule12(3)of MCDR,1988.
