Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR 1988 in respect of Khatkurbahal Limestone Mine in Sundergarh-district of Odisha State

Sir.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 27.06.2013 by the undersigned, accompanied by Sri. Rampal Kapoor, Agent and Tofan Singh, Geologist of your mine.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the Mining Plan approved dated 21.12.2011 to the extent indicated below :-
13 (1)	Ref. Para 4.4, Page 16 and Para 6.0, Page 20 of PMCP; Retaining wall (300mx1.5mx1m), garland drain (100mx1mx1m) and Settling Tank (5mx1mx2m) have not been constructed to arrest wash-offs from the waste dump as approved in the said Mining Plan.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute **an offence punishable** under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

"58 Penalty: Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to two years, or with fine extending to fifty thousand rupees or with both, and in the case of continuing contraventions with an additional fine which may extend up to five thousand rupees for every day during which such contraventions continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeated contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only".

Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13 (1) is also liable for **suspension of mining operations** according to Rule 13 (2) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
