Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules,2017, in respect of your THENMALAI Limestone mine over 1.11 HA in THENMALAI village, SIVAGIRI taluk, TIRUNELVELI district of Tamilnadu State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the MCDR, 2017 was found violated in your above mine during the MCDR inspection by Sri T.Phalthurai Rajhen, Asst., Mining Geologist on 26/02/2018 in presence of Sri chinna venkata raja and the following has been communicated by this office violation letter of even number dated 19/03/2018 .

Rule No	Nature of Violation observed
28(1)	Subject to the provisions of section 4A, the holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorized officer , as the case may be and the state government a notice in form E when the mining or mineral processing operation in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them within one hundred and twenty days from the date of such temporary discontinuance. Till date no such notice is received in the office.

02. You have not responded to this office letter dated.19/03/2018¹ till date. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

03. You are therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
