Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your Chandan limestone mine (5.605 hect.) in Katni District of Madhya Pradesh.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection on 08.08.2017 by undersigned.

**Rule 11(1)** The mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the approved or certified mining plan or any information contained in the mining plan is found to be incorrect, misleading or non-compliant with applicable laws.

Modification in approved mining plan along with PMCP of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/Katni/Limestone/MPLN/MOD-46/2017-18, dated 16/05/2017 incorporating proposals from 2017-18 to 2021-22. During the inspection it was observed that mining operations in the mine was not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the approved document. The extents of deviation observed during the inspection are as under:

*As per approved document, in chapter geology and exploration (page no 17), it was proposed to drill four (4) core borehole and eight (8) numbers of trenches with the diemensions of (40-30mX3mX2-3m) during the year 2017-18 . During the inspection it was observed that exploratory boreholes and trenches as proposal for the year 2017-18 has not been done till date.*

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.

4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
