Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of Hemadri Limestone Mine over an extent of 38.68 ha situated in Vedadri village, Jaggayyapeta mandal in Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the MCDR-2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 23.02.2020 by the undersigned in the presence of Sri Ram Reddy-Mines Manager, Sri S.Naresh Kumar- Geologist.

Rule No-11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.	Review of Mining Plan was approved without prejudice to any other law applicable to mining lease area from time to time made by Central Government or the State Government. vide this office letter No AP/KSN/MP/Lst-32/HYD dated 15.05.2018 for the period 2018-19 to 2022-23, where in a) It was proposed to construct Parapet wall/retaining wall and Garland drain each of 450m X 1.5m X 1m dimension at the toe of dumps during the year 2018-19, but as on date of inspection no such retaining wall and garland drain were constructed. b) It was proposed to plant 1500 nos Plant in 0.875 Ha at slope of the dump during the year 2018-19, but as on date of inspection no such plantation were carried out. From the above it is evident that you have not carried out the mining operations as per the review of mining plan as approved by Indian Bureau of Mines.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an Offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
