**Subject:** Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Jhansi-silva iron ore and blue dust mine(area-4.56 hect) in District of Jabalpur in M.P. State.

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 27/02/2020 by the undersigned in presence of Mr Haroon,owner representative and Mines manager .

<b>Rule 26(2) MCDR 2017</b>	(2) The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof. <b>Statement/yearly report for progressive closure under this rule for yr 18-19 is not submitted.</b>
<b>Rule 45 MCDR 2017</b>	45(5) .The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner, namely:- (b) a monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective form as indicated below:- i. for all minerals except copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten, zinc, precious and semi-precious stones, in Form F1 of the Schedule; ii. for copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten and zinc, in Form F2 of the Schedule; and iii. for precious and semi-precious stones, in Form F3 of the Schedule; (c) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective Form as indicated below:- (i) for all minerals except copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten, zinc, precious and semi-precious stones, in Form G1 of the Schedule; (ii) for copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten and zinc, in Form G2 of the Schedule; (iii) for precious and semi-precious stones, in Form G3 of the Schedule. <b>Annual returns/monthly returns for mine is not submitted for year 18-19 online as required under above rule.</b>
<b>Rule 55 of MCDR 2017</b>	Employment of geologists and mining engineers.-(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules,- 1. every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist; 2. every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license cum mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer; 3. every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of- (iii) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist; (iv) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist. <b>A full time geologist is not appointed as per rule for the mines.</b>
<b>Rule 35 of MCDR 2017</b>	35. Sustainable mining.-(1) Every holder of a mining lease shall take all possible precautions for undertaking sustainable mining while conducting prospecting, mining, beneficiation or metallurgical operations in the area. (2) Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its selfassessment report before the 1st day of July every year for the previous financial year, alongwith the soft copy (in the standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31st day of March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometres. from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorised officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines. <b>Self assessment template for sustainable mining is not submitted for yr 18-19 under this rule for your mine.</b>

02.In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.


03 .You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
