PART – II – TECHNICAL DETAILS

 Sensitive technical items on conservation of mineral, scientific mining and protection of environment – status of Present Mining Operations vis-à-vis approved proposals of mining plan / Scheme of Mining:----

1) Scientific mining

<u>i) Exploration</u>: No exploration was carried out during the recent past and no exploration is proposed to be carried out in the balance period of lease. In the lease area, the nature of mineralization of deposit could easily be assessed from exposure in the existing pit as there is no OB.

<u>ii) Workings</u>: During inspection, it was observed that there is a deviation in the site of working and excavation is also noticed in statutory barrier. The mining operations were found in unscientific and unsystematic manner, as the lessee excavated without leaving the safety barrier i.e public buildings/auditorium, panchayat road and HT line/tower. The excavation already carried out in the North West part of the lease area was significantly on higher side than the proposed. The proposed area for excavation during the fourth year as per approved mining plan, has already been excavated. The lessee has excavated two numbers of pits and their dimensions of existing pits are viz 1) 55.6m X 23.16 m X 1.16m and 2) 25.70mx6.40mx1.13m respectively. The mining operations are being carried manually with pickaxes & crowbars. There is no OB existing and no drilling & blasting is required.

There is no adverse impact on air, water and noise inside the ML area because mining is being carried out **on a small scale**. The excavated pit areas are backfilled by filling up with building waste and other road metal including soil waste.

II) A note on justification in case of suspension of mining operations under rule 13(2) or prohibition of deployment of any person under rule 56 of MCDR, 1988 if recommended:---

The mining operations were found in unscientific and unsystematic manner, as the lessee excavated without leaving the statutory barrier i.e public buildings/auditorium, panchayat road and HT line/tower. It was also observed that the excavation already carried out in the North West part of the lease area was significantly on higher side than the proposed. The proposed area for excavation during the fourth year as per approved mining plan, has already been excavated. Moreover, the working proposal of 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 has not been carried out in location as proposed in Approved Mining Plan. It was also observed that mined out pits were back filled with waste consisting of mixed red soil brought from outside, intimation to the Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller of his intention to abandon a mine or a part of a mine not given. It is thus recommended that further operation in any of the workings in the mine is stopped immediately by application of Rule 13(2) of MCDR 1988.

III) Any other matter of significance:---No statutory personnel like Manager, Mate & Mining Engineer employed at the mine.
