l) Sensitive technical items on conservation of mineral, scientific mining and protection of environment – status of Present Mining Operations vis-à-vis approved proposals of mining plan / Scheme of Mining:----

**1) Scientific mining**

**i) Exploration:** There is no proposals exploration during period 2008-09 to 2012-13. However, the lessee had drilled 5 numbers of boreholes with total meterage of 150 m. During inspection the boreholes logs kept in core-boxes as well as location of boreholes in the field were shown to the inspecting team.

**ii) Workings:** The mining operation has been temporarily discontinued w.e.f. 15/01/2011 due to lack of demand and ownership disputes. During inspection, it was observed that mine is in inoperative condition for the reasons mentioned. The dimension of existing pit is 130 m X 40 m X 20m .




