Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of JarahMohgaon Manganese Mine (Area 11.766 ha)

Sir

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 are found violated in your above mine during inspection on 28/09/2013 by ShriHarkeshMeena, Deputy Controller of Mines, Jabalpur (Team Leader) and **Dr. A. K. Ghoshal**, Junior Mining Geologist, Nagpur Regional Office, accompanied by Shri R. P. Kamlesh, Assistant Mining Officer, A. K. Nagle, Mining Inspector and M. A. Quereshi, Mining Surveyor, DGM, Balaghat, Govt. of M.P. and ShriGhanshyamKawale, Mine Foreman and Ajay Kumar Acharya, HR of your mine.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
23 F (3)	The financial assurance has to be furnished by every lease holder. The amount of financial assurance shall be Rs. 25,000/- for 'A' category mines and Rs. 15,000/- for 'B' category mines per hectare of the mining lease area put to use for mining and allied activities. However, the minimum amount of financial assurance to be furnished in any of the forms referred to in clause 2 of Rule 23F shall be Rs. 2 lacs for 'A' category mines and Rs.1 lac for 'B' category mine. But it was observed on examination of records of lessee pertaining to this lease area, that the required financial assurance has not been submitted to this office under Rule 23 F(3) of MCDR 1988. This is a case of fresh grant. The financial assurance should be submitted before execution of mining lease. But the lease has been executed without submitting the financial assurance to the Regional Controller of Mines (NR).

03 It is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

04. You are therefore directed to **SHOW CAUSE** within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why mining operations in your mine should not be suspended under rule 13(2) for the violation of provision of rule 13(1) as above.
