Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Teherai Iron & Manganese Mine in Sundargarh District of Odisha, over an extent of 137.46ha-Reg.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred as MCDR, 2017) were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 13.07.2017 by undersigned accompanied by Shri Abhijit Sen, AVP(Geology), Shri A.S. Mohapatra, AVP(Mining), Shri B.K Srivastava, Mines Manager & Shri K.K. Sha, Senior Inspector of Mines, O/o the Deputy Director of Mines, Koira.

Rule	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.....or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the modification of scheme of mining approved vide letter number MSM/FM/04-ORI/BHU/2015-16, dated 21.07.2015. The extent deviation is as given below: Plantation for the year 2016-17 was proposed on the backfilling area of 2015-16 in Chattan Pit in between the gridlines N800-N1000 & E600-E750 (DRG. No. 09) but no plantation has not been as per the proposal envisaged in the approved document for the said year.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provisions of rule 11(1) also liable for suspension of mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017.
- You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
