
The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 15.12.2016 by undersigned in the presence of Shri Siddharth Verma & Shri Vikeshwar Thakur (Maneger Mines).

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
45(5)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner, namely:- a monthly return which shall be submitted before the 10th of every month in respect of preceding month in the prescribed Form under this rule. However during the inspection it has been observed that the monthly returns has not been submitted since April 2016.
42(1)(c)(ii)	For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules:“Every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category ‘B’ mines, a part time mining engineer and a part time Geologist”. However during the inspection it was observed that a part time Mining Engineer /Geologist has not been employed under this rule.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rules 45(7) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under the provision of Rule 45(7) of MCDR, 1988.


03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.


