Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your **Jeerabad Limestone Mine (21.08 Hect.) in Dhar district of M.P.**


The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 06/01/2022 by the undersigned in presence of Shri Vijay K Chakunde (Mine Manager), Shri Kallipri Nagaraja Rao (Mine Geologist), Shri K K Shrama (Mine Surveyor) and other officials. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated.

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.</p> <p>The Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-NP/DHR/LST/MPLN-1163/NGP/2015 dated 30/07/2016 incorporating the proposals of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25.</p> <p>During the year 2020-21, it was proposed to develop 21000 M² area as Pit-A in the western part of Block-A. But, it was observed that no mine development was carried out as per approved document.</p>
Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</p> <p>The yearly report of PMCP has not been submitted for the previous approved plan period.</p>

Rule 33	<p>Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.</p> <p>Copies of updated plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.</p>
Rule 63(1)	<p>Preservation of cores, etc.-(1) Every holder of a mineral concession and every agency authorized under the second proviso to sub-section (1) of section 4 shall preserve intact, until submission of the final geological report, all cores and specimens of different types of rocks and minerals obtained during drilling or sinking operations and shall arrange for them to be laid out in a serial order with identification marks, showing the progressive depth at which, they are obtained.</p> <p>During the inspection, it was observed that the core samples of boreholes and records were not kept systematically.</p>

01. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
02. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
