Subject: Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Balwari limestone mine(area-4.90Hect) in village-Balwari, Tehsil-Gandhawaniin, District Dhar in M.P. State

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 29/12/2021 by the undersigned in presence of Mr Sanjay khandelwal , Owner of Mines and Lessee.

Rule 11(1) MCDR 2017	<p>(1).Mining operations under mining lease.-(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved,modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules,2016.</p> <p>During inspection, for the year 2020-21 ,it is observed,</p> <p>Productio , development, backfilling , plantatation that is none of proposals of approved mining plan for the year 20-21 are implemented.</p> <p>Thus, there is violation of this rule.</p>
Rule 28	<p>28. Notice of temporary discontinuance of work in mines and obligations of lease holders.-(1) Subject to the provisions of section 4A, the holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government a notice in Form E when the mining or mineral processing operations in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them within one hundred and twenty days from the date of such temporary discontinuance.</p> <p>Mines is in not in operation in year 20-21 ,for period of more than 90 days,but no notice of discontinuance is submitted to this office in form E.</p>
Rule 29	<p>Intimation of reopening of a mine.-The holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government an intimation in Form C of the Schedule of reopening of a mine after temporary discontinuance, so as to reach them within fifteen days from the date of such reopening.</p> <p>Mines is operational in year 21-22,but no notice of reopening is given as per this rule.</p>
Rule 55 of MCDR 2017	<p>Employment of geologists and mining engineers.-(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules,- 1. every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist; 2. every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license cum mining lease shall employ a whole-time</p>

geologist and a part-time mining engineer; 3. every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of- (iii) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist; (iv) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

Part time geologist and mining engineer are not appointed as per rule for the mines.

45(5) .The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner, namely:-
(b) a monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective form as indicated below:-
i. for all minerals except copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten, zinc, precious and semi-precious stones, in Form F1 of the Schedule;
ii. for copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten and zinc, in Form F2 of the Schedule; and
iii. for precious and semi-precious stones, in Form F3 of the Schedule;
(c) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective Form as indicated below:-
(i) for all minerals except copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten, zinc, precious and semi-precious stones, in Form G1 of the Schedule;
(ii) for copper, gold, lead, pyrite, tin, tungsten and zinc, in Form G2 of the Schedule;
(iii) for precious and semi-precious stones, in Form G3 of the Schedule:

Following violations are observed for on line submitted Annual return:

A. It is observed that annual return is not submitted in time.

B. The submitted return is incomplete in following respects:

- i) information on manager, is not given**
- ii) information on capital structure of mines is not given.**
- iii) land use details at year end under para 12 are not furnished.**
- iv) in XI-(i) particulars of operational area, area under and non forest is not mentioned.**
- v) The reserves and resources are not given at year end after updation in part V.**
- vi) In mining chapter, details of benches, depth of working etc are not mentioned.**

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter and also pay the applicable fine wherever indicated.
