Subject:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your **Majhgawan extension Limestone Mines** (area-54.825Hect.) in District of **Sidhi in M.P. State.**


The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 11.06.2021 by the undersigned in presence of Shree Sreenu babu, Mines Head and Mr. Gaurav Sharma, Geologist.

Rule 11(1) MCDR 2017	<p>(1).Mining operations under mining lease.--(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved,modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules,2016.</p> <p>(2) If the mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the approved or certified mining plan or any information contained in the mining plan is found to be incorrect, misleading or non-compliant with applicable laws including these rules, the competent authority may by order, suspend all or any of the mining operations and permit continuance of only such operations as are required to restore the conditions in the mine as envisaged under the approved or certified mining plan or modified mining plan, for the purpose of restoration to the extent possible :</p> <p>During inspection, for the year 2020-21 ,it is observed,</p> <p>1.Backfilling in pit no-2 is not done to the extent in proposal.(1.0 Hect. is planned & 0.2 is achieved.)</p> <p>2. plantation done in green belt is not having good survival rate(50% against planned 80%)</p> <p>3. production achieved is only 499922 Taginst planned quantity of 10,00,000 T of limestone.</p> <p>Thus there is violation of this rule.</p>

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
