The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 29/12/2021 by the undersigned in presence of Mr Sanjay khandelwal ,Owner's representative.

- 3. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.
- 4. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
