45(5)(c)	authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner. ${ m {\it C}}$ an annual return which shall be submitted
	before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form along with a signed print copy
	of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form. In your case, you have not submitted the online Annual
	return of 2020-21 to this office till date.

2. On examination of office record, it is found that you have submitted reply of violations dated 29/10/21 received in this office on 01.11.2021 but not found satisfactory for compliance of rules 11(1) & 45(5)(b) & 45(5)(c) and it is found that violation of provision of rules 11(1), & 45(5)(b) & 45(5)(c) is still persists

3. In this connection, it is brought to your kind notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.

4. Mining operations can be suspended as per rule 11(2) in case of non-compliance of rule 11(1) and any other relevant rules of MCDR 2017 as these rules ensures systematic scientific and responsible mining.

5. Mining operations can be suspended as per provision of Rule 45(7)(iii), in case if it is found that the holder of a mining lease, has fails to submit such return within the date specified under Rule 45 and or amount to be paid as per provision of 45(7A) Schedule-II of amended MCDR,2017.

6. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the compliance position to this office within 30 days from date of issue of this letter.

- 7. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and / or penalty/fine etc. to be imposed and /or why the mining operation should not be suspended under relevant statutory provisions and/or why not any other appropriate action can be initiated in accordance with rules and/or any competent orders/directives.
- 8. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
