

2017 in respect of your Vishvada Bauxite Mines, Sy. No.-731/P, over an area of

20.2342 ha located near Village- Vishvada, District-Porbandar in Gujarat.

महोदय / Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection made by the undersigned on 30.06.2021 in the presence of your representative Shri Dhrumil Makhecha:

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area
	except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the
	Indian Bureau of Mines
	In Your case during inspection it was found that as per approved mining plan proposal for
	2020-21 it was proposed to keep the Floor of Pit 1 at 14.00 mRL throughout the Pit and
	during Inspection it was found that the floor of existing Pit 1 was undulating.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report
	as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1stday of July every
	year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as
	envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons
	thereof
	In your case it was found that yearly report for the Year 2020-21 for the extent of protective
	and rehabilitative work carried out has not been submitted.
33	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted.—The holder of a mining lease
	shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorised officer, as
	the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the
	surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.
	In your case it was found that Digital copy along with print copy of Surface Geological Plan
	as maintained under Rule 32 of MCDR 2017 has not been submitted to this office
34(1)	All digitally prepared plans, sections and print copies there of kept at the mine shall be
	suitably indexed.
	In your case during inspection the digitally prepared updated plans & sections were not
	present during inspection. (Rule 34(1) of MCDR 2017 should be read with Rule 31(4) of
	MCDR 2017, which clearly says Plans & Sections required under these rules shall be
	maintained up to date within 3 months in case of category "A" mines.)

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
