Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of Muddapur Limestone Mine (ML-2645) over an extent of 4.65 Hectares situated in Muddapur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District of Karnataka State - Reg.

Sir,

Undersigned inspected your above mine on 09.01.2018 in presence of the mine officials Shri.Narasinga Moorthy, Mines Consultant and Violation letter of even number KNT/BGM/LST-100/GOA dated 25/01/2018 was issued for below mentioned rules of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017.

11 (1)	<p>Mining operations in the lease area are not carried out as per the last approved Mining Scheme. The following deviation is observed during inspection,</p> <p>a) It was a proposed in para 1.i, to drill 4 Boreholes during the Scheme Period in the lease area, against which no exploration work has been taken up so far. (Violation issued on 28.06.2016)</p> <p>b) It was proposed in Para 2.C & Plate-6.B, to produce Limestone above 529m RL and upto Boundary pillar-G and Dolomite upto Section line B-B'. But, on the day of inspection, it was observed, that the no operation were carried out at proposed RL & Area and Dolomite has worked beyond section line B-B'.</p> <p>c) It is proposed in Page-3 to keep all the benches of height at 3m each and rectified for systematic bench development, whereas in the field it is observed to be more than the proposed height.</p> <p>d) It is proposed in Page-26 that budget has been allotted for CSR activity. But, on the day of inspection, it was noticed, no amount has been spending under CSR.</p> <p>e) Valid EC is for only 5,000 tons for Limestone & 20,000 tons for Dolomite, whereas mining scheme proposal is 10,000 tons & 50,000. Hence it should be modified.</p>
26 (2)	<p>A yearly report before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved progressive mine closure plan has not been submitted for last year 2016-2017.</p>
27 (1)	<p>A financial assurance shall be furnished by the holder of the mining lease, for due and proper implementation of the progressive mine closure plan contained in the mining plan or the final mine closure plan, as the case may be, which shall be an amount of three lakh rupees for Category 'A' mines and two lakh rupees for Category 'B' mines, per hectare of the mining lease area put to use for mining and allied activities:</p> <p>Provided that the minimum amount of financial assurance to be furnished under sub-rule (1), shall be ten lakh rupees for Category 'A' mines and five lakh rupees for Category 'B' mines:</p>

27 (2)	where financial assurance has already been furnished before the commencement of these rules, an amount equal to the difference between the financial assurance due as on the date of notification of these rules and the financial assurance already furnished, shall be furnished to the authorised officer, as the case may be within a period of ninety days from the date of notification of these rules
33	The plans & sections prepared under rule 33 for the year 2016-2017 have not been submitted on or before 30 th June 2017.
55(1)(3)(iv)	The mine is being operated without employing the part time or full time Mining Geologist or Mining Engineer required under the provision this rule.
67	Obligation to supply other information <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Self-Appraisal Report to be submitted by owner of the mine under Rule 67 of MCDR, 2017 stating extent of implementation of Approved Mining Plan/ Scheme of Mining during the year 2016 – 2017 along with supporting plans & sections representative photographs in hard as well as soft copy.

2. However, it has been found that even after lapse of **45 days** from the issue of violation letter you have not responded the violation till date, the violations for the Rule 11(1), 26(2), 27(1), 27(2), 33, 55(1)(3)(iv), and 67 remain to be continued.
3. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under **Rule 62** of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017.
4. The Mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2) if compliance of Rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
5. You are therefore, directed to show cause within a period of **thirty (30) days** as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence and/or why mining operations shall not be suspended as per provision of Rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017.
6. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
