Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Sitapathore Mn Ore Mine (4.250 Ha), Minecode-40MPR01046 at Village Sitapathore, Tehsil- Katangi, District- Balaghat (M.P.).

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on 16/06/2021 in the presence of Shri. R.K.Choubey (QP).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter NoMP /Balaghat / Manganese/ RMP-55/18-19 dated 07/03/2019 incorporating proposal of working from 2016-17 to 2020-21. During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: - 1. The benches are found merged creating highwall in the entire mine except few places. 2. Exploration is not carried out against proposal of 07 boreholes. 3. It was proposed to generate 1972 cubic meter of soil for the year 2020-21 but nil achieved. 4. It was proposed to generate 38587 cubic meter of waste for the year 2020-21 but nil achieved. 5. It was proposed to produce 6854 tonnes of manganese ore for the year 2020-21 but nil achieved. 6. It was proposed to carry out 125 nos of plantation for the year 2020-21 but nil achieved.
26(2)	Yearly report in respect of reclamation and rehabilitative works carried out has no been submitted for the year 2019-20.
45(5)(b)	Monthly returns have not been submitted since September 2020. Annual Return fo the last 03 financial years are not submitted.
45(5)(c)	Annual return for the preceding financial year was not submitted.

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of

rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.

3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
