Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of Siluwa & Jhansi Iron Ore Mine, Mine code-30MPR18024 over an area of 4.56 Ha, in District Jabalpur of Madhya Pradesh State.

Sir/Madam,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of your re-presentative and Shri M.M.Gosavi (Qualified Person) on 11/05/2021. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection:

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. The Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter NoMP /Jabalpur / Iron Ore/ MPLN / G-03/15-16 dated 03/05/2016. During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: -
	(a) Only 02 boreholes are drilled against the proposal of 05 boreholes during the last Mine Plan document period.
	(b) Only 433 cubic meter of OB is generated against the proposal of 5595 cubic meter for the year 2020-21.
	(c) No intercalacted waste is generated against the proposal of 10593 cubic meter for the year 2020-21.
	(d) Only 750 tonnes of Iron ore is generated against the proposal of 18361 tonnes for the year 2020-21.
Rule 26(2)	Yearly report in respect of protective and rehabilitative works carried out has not been submitted for the year 2019-20.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
