Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of Naganapur Limestone & Dolomite Mine (ML-2425) over an extent of 2.78 Hectares situated in Naganapur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District of Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provision of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 was found violated in your above mine during the inspection on **03/08/2019** by the undersigned.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations observed
11(1)	The mining operations in the Lease area are not carried out as per the last approved Review of mining plan. a) It was a proposed in Page-16 to drill 2 Boreholes during the year 2018-2019 in the lease area, against which no exploration work has been taken up so far. b) As per page no-34 & plate-6 there is an approved dumping proposal for stacking the waste material on southern side of lease area. During inspection it was noticed that waste has not been dumped as per proposal. c) It is proposed in page-34, to construct Toe wall and Garland Drainage along the bottom of dump, but during inspection it was noticed that no wall and drainage has been constructed. d) During inspection it was noticed that ROM has been stocked outside the lease boundary on Northern side and adjoining lease also.
26(2)	A yearly report before 1 st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved progressive mine closure plan has not been submitted for last year 2018-2019.
33	The plans & sections prepared under rule 33 for the year 2018-2019 have not been submitted on or before 30 th June 2019.

35 (2)	Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the 1st day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy (in the standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31 st day of March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometers from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines. It is observed that has not submitted for the year 2018-2019
55(1)(3) (iii)	The mine is being operated without employing the full time Mining Engineer/ Mining Geologist required under the provision this rule.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2) if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
