Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development, 2017 in respect of your Jinkalatippa Limestone Mine of Shri Khasim Shavali over an extent of 13.593 ha situated in Sy.nos 519/A1 and 642/2A of Malkapuram village, Dhone Mandal, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 04.7.2017 by Shri Y.M.Shiva Prasad, Asst.Mining Engineer of this office in the presence of Sri Khasim Shaik Shavali Lessee.

Rule No.	Rule Position	Nature of violation observed
<b>11(1)</b>	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the Mining Plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.	Modified Mining plan for Jinkalatippa Limestone Mine was approved on 25.8.2016 for the period 2016-17, which expired on 31.3.2017. The scheme of mining/Review of Mining Plan for next five years was due for submission to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad for the subsequent periods, at least 180 days before the expiry of period for which the Modified mining Plan approved on the last occasion and the same has not been submitted so far.
<b>11(4)</b>	The holder of mining lease shall submit the review of mining plan to the competent authority for review at least one hundred and eighty days before the expiry of five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of five subsequent years.	Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining. Since you have no approved Scheme of Mining/Review of Mining Plan for your above mentioned Mine, it is evident that the mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved Review of Mining Plan.
<b>45(6)(a)</b>	Any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, shall submit online to the INDIAN BUREAU OF MINES and concerned State Government, where the said person or company is sourcing the minerals, the returns in electronic form, along with a print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the following manner, namely : (a) monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in Form L of the Schedule	Monthly returns since January 2016 have not been submitted in form L to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Hyderabad so far as required under the rule which ought to have been submitted before 10th of every month in respect of preceding month.

<b>45(6)(b)</b>	Any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, shall submit online to the INDIAN BUREAU OF MINES and concerned State Government, where the said person or company is sourcing the minerals, the returns in electronic form, along with a print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the following manner, namely : (b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the first day of July of each year for the preceding financial year in form M of the schedule.	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines returns in respect of each mine in the following manner, namely :-The Annual Returns for the year 2016-17 have not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Hyderabad so far as required under the rule. The Annual Returns should be submitted before 1 <sup>st</sup> July of every year in respect of preceding year.

02. It is to bring to your notice that the above violation constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provisions of rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR 2017.
03. You are therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from date of issue of this letter.
