Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Deevlopment Rules, 2017 in respect of your Tavasikonda Iron Ore of Shri B.Sanjeeva Reddy mine over an extent of 32.003 ha situated in Tavasikonda Village, Bethamcherla Mandal, Kurnool District of Andhra Pradesh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR ,2017 ) were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 05.07.2017 by Shri Y.M.Shiva Prasad, Asisstant Mining Engineer of this office, accompanied by Sri Basha Mines Manager:

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the Mining Plan approved, modified or reviewd by the Indian Bureau of Mines.	Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Scheme of Mining approved vide this office letter No.AP/KNL/Fe-12/Hyd dated 18.11.2014 to the extent indicated below : It was approved to carry out exploration by 06 nos of core bore holes for the year 2016-17, against which no exploration was carried out so far.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 <sup>st</sup> day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.	The yearly report for the year 2016-17 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved scheme of Mining has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.
45(6)(a)	Any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, shall submit online to the INDIAN BUREAU OF MINES and concerned State Government, where the said person or company is sourcing the minerals, the returns in electronic form, along with a print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the following manner, namely : (a) monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in Form L of the Schedule.	Monthly returns since Januvary 2016 have not been submitted in form L to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Hyderabad so far as required under the rule which ought to have been submitted before 10 <sup>th</sup> of every month in respect of preceding month
45(6)(b)	Any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, shall submit online to the INDIAN BUREAU OF MINES and concerned State Government, where the said person or company is sourcing the minerals, the returns in electronic form, along with a print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the following manner, namely : . (b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the first day of July of each year for the preceding financial year in form M of the schedule.	The owner ,agent,mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regioinal Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any othorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines returns in respect of each mine in the following manner, namely :-The Annual Returns for the year 2016-17 have not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Hyderabad so far as required under the rule. The Annual Returns should be submitted before 1 <sup>st</sup> July of every year in respect of preceding financial year has not been submitted for the year 2016-17.

02. It is to bring to your notice that the above violation constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides ,inability to comply the provisions of rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR 2017.
03. You are therefore ,advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence.
