Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017 in respect of "Bimarla" Bauxite Mine Mining code 07JHK09007 over an area of 134.37 Hects. at Gumla District of Jharkhand State – reg.

Sir,

On the examination of this office records, it is observed that the following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 are violated in respect of your above referred mine.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations observed
45(7) (b)(i)	On scrutiny of the Annual Returns for the year 2020-21 of your above mentioned mine following discrepancy were observed:- <ol style="list-style-type: none">Direct cost figure in Part-VII is not matching with the cost figure mentioned in Employment & Wages Part-II and Consumption of Materials Part-III.Depreciation figure in Part-VII should be Rs. 84.99/- instead of Rs. 26.87/- also Land depreciation value during the year may be verified.Sale tax Rs. 7466255/- has been mentioned in Taxes and Cesses Section in Part-III item 5 but taxes figure is not mentioned in Cost of Production Section.In Part-VI item 2, Ex-mine price of 40% to below 45% Al₂O₃ is Rs. 1064.61/- but in Part-VI item 5, Sale value is Rs. 1170/-.It may be clarified. (Note: Ex-mine price of Non-Captive mine should be more than cost of production)As per Monthly Returns for the month of April-2020 to March-2021 submitted by you, total Sale value is Rs. 124127613.98/- but in Annual Returns 2020-21 total Sale value is Rs. 138765170/-.

2. It is brought to your kind notice that, if it is found that the holder of mining lease has submitted incomplete and wrong information in monthly or annual returns and if the above rules are not complied; the Regional Controller of Mines may advise to State Government to take following action under rule 45(7)(a) of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017:

- order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;
- take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;

iii. recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;

3. You are, therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45(forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
