Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017 in respect of "Vijay-II" Iron Mine Mining code 30JHK18015 over an area of 155.078 Hects. in Singhbhum (W) District of Jharkhand State - reg.

Sir,

On the examination of this office records, it is observed that the following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 are violated in respect of your above referred mine.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations observed
45(7)	<p>i. On examination of Annual Returns for the year 2020-21, it is observed that ex-mine price as reflected in Part-VI item 3 is not matching with cost of production figure as reported in Part VII.</p> <p>ii. On examination of Monthly Returns (F-1) for the month of July-2021, it is observed that reported Grades &amp; Quantity of Iron Ore (Lumps &amp; Fines) dispatched from mines are not matching with reported Grades &amp; Quantity received at Gamharia Plant as reported in Form-N for the month of July-2021 i.r.o. Gamharia Plant.</p>


2. It is brought to your kind notice that, if it is found that the holder of mining lease has submitted incomplete and wrong information in monthly or annual returns and if the above rules are not complied; the Regional Controller of Mines may advise to State Government to take following action under rule 45(7)(a) of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017:

- order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;
- take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;
- recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;



On examination of Monthly Return (M-1) for the month of July-2021, it is observed that reported Quantity & Weighting of Iron Ore (Lump & Fines) dispatched from mines are not matched with reported Quantity & Weighting of Iron Ore (Lump & Fines) reported in Part-VI for the month of July-2021.
2.	It is noted that the report of mining lease has submitted accordingly and every information is furnished to mining lease and if the lease is not completed the Regional Controller and Development Officer, Jharkhand, should report the same to the Controller of Mines, India.
