Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Roida-II Iron ore mine, over an extent of 74.867 hectare in Keonjhar District.

Sir,

The following provisions of MCDR,2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 15/07/2017 by undersigned in presence of Sri A.K. Chaudhary, Geologist & Shri P.K. Mohanty, Mines Manager.

Rule No.	Nature of violations observed
11(1)	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the review of Mining Plan, approved vide this office letter number MPM/FM/11-ORI/BHU/2016-17 dated 23.09.2016 to the extent given below: 1) In 2015-16 and 2016-17, it was proposed to re-handle the mineral reject/sub grade dump lies in eastern part of the pit-6. However it has been observed during inspection that mineral reject/sub grade dump has not been re-handled. 2) Mineral stack yard is proposed in northern side of quarry-2 between grid 100N and 200N. However it has been observed during inspection that mineral stacked in different places of mine against the approved proposal.
45(5)(c)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online annual return before the 1 st July of each year for preceding financial year in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed. However, it has been observed that annual return for the year 2016-17 has not been submitted to this office.

02 In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory and may recommended for suspension/termination of mining lease under rule 45(7)(a), if rule 45(5)(c) is not complied.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
